**NOTE:** It is necessary to determine how much punishment in the lake of fire each wicked person and angel (including Satan) will receive in the final punishment for sin. So God has decided that the redeemed will conduct this work of sentencing judgment.

"They are to sit with Christ in the judgment, but not to determine who shall be saved or who is lost. God the Father has already pronounced the decision of who shall have immortality and the Son has executed the decision by immortalizing his saints. "But rather to determine (judge) the degrees or length of

punishment the lost shall receive." [The Judgment, 117: John Nevis Andrews]

**Second**, by examining the records, all of the redeemed will have an opportunity to understand exactly why the wicked have been lost. If this examination had not been made, a question might remain in some minds through all eternity, as to why certain ones who on earth had made such a high profession of godliness were not saved.

The Bible says someday, "that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow...and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" [Philippians 2:10-11].
